What's happening?

We're renewing tram tracks along Mt Alexander Road between Mooltan Street and Dean Street, and overhead wires between Fletcher Street and Shamrock Street.

These essential works will reduce risk of derailments along this portion of the tram network. Renewal works will also deliver improved ride, comfort and safety for our passengers and ensure a quieter infrastructure for the community.

	Route 59 7pm Monday 3 January to last tram Monday 17 January
	Buses replace trams on some sections of Route 58 and 59 . Buses divert around the work zones and stop changes apply.
	Street closures and detours will be in place. Follow the orange signage at tram stops and around the work zones.
	Mount Alexander Road will be closed to all traffic in two sections from Dean Street to Sydney Street (including the intersection at Ormond Road*) and South Street to Mooltan Street. *Intersection will re-open on 5am Saturday 8 January.
	Trams operate from a satellite depot at Royal Park while works take place at Essendon Depot.

Alternative travel options

- Craigieburn** trains between the city and Essendon Station.
- Upfield** trains between the city and Coburg Station.
- Route 19** trams along Elizabeth Street, Royal Parade and Sydney Road.
- Buses between Moonee Ponds Interchange and Sydney Road connecting with **Route 19** trams:
 - **Bus 508** travelling along Victoria Street
 - **Bus 506** travelling along Dawson Street.
- Buses between Essendon Station and Sydney Road to connect with **Route 19** trams:
 - **Bus 510** travelling along Moreland Road
 - **Bus 503** travelling along Albion Street

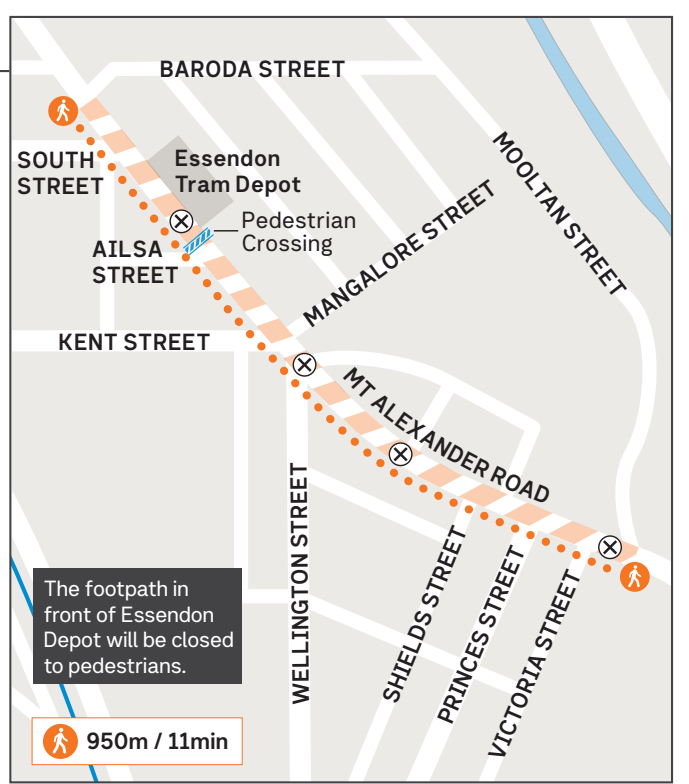
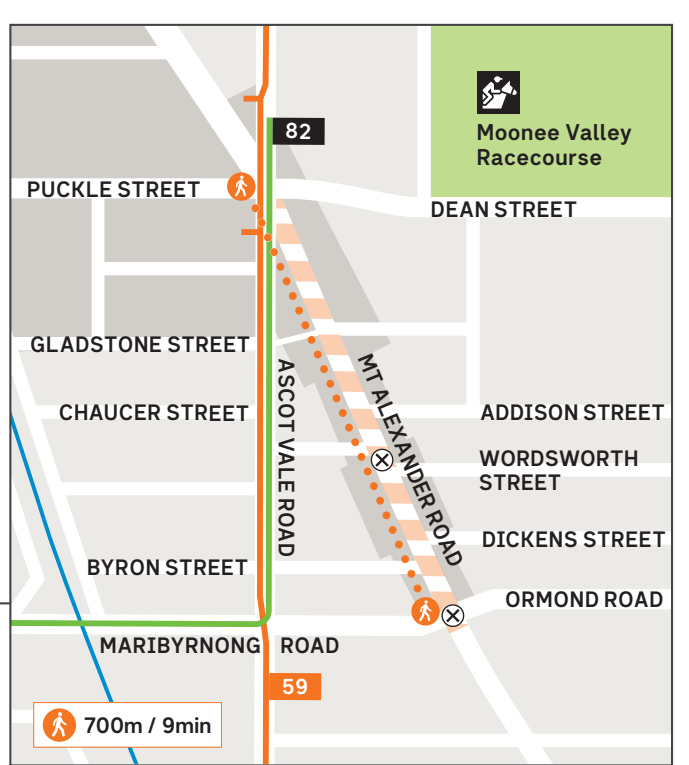

Trams run in sections with buses replacing trams between Stop 19 Royal Children's Hospital and Stop 27 Royal Park Station.
- Route 59**
7pm Monday 3 January to last tram Monday 17 January
Trams run a shortened service between Flinders Street Station and Stop 20 Melrose St. Buses replace trams between Stop 19 Royal Children's Hospital and Airport West. Buses divert around the work zones and stop changes apply.
