Community Update 3

The Department of Transport and Planning (DTP) and Yarra Trams are upgrading the Brunswick Tram Depot to support the addition of larger trams to the fleet, additional trams in the depot and provide improved accessibility and safety.

We're constructing a new, larger car park under the elevated rail line to allow for additional depot staff. The existing staff car park will be used for the upgrade of the depot. Due to continued difficult ground conditions encountered during excavation works, additional time is required to complete construction of the car park. The completion date has been extended to the end of September 2024.

To prepare for the installation of new overhead tram poles, we're carrying out service proving to locate underground utility services. We require additional time to complete this activity due to continued difficult ground conditions. The completion date for these investigations has been extended to the end of August 2024.

New Brunswick Tram Depot staff car park

Where?

Under the elevated rail line, between the Upfield Shared Path and Colebrook Street, Brunswick. (See map overleaf for more information.)

When?

Ongoing 7am to 4pm, to the end of September 2024 (Monday to Friday only).

Occasional night works will be required with low to medium noise.

Service proving investigations

Where?

- Cameron Street.
- Sydney Road, near the depot building.
- Along the western edge of the pedestrian path in the rail corridor.

What to expect?

- Vehicles, machinery and contractors on site.
- Mostly medium level noise, with some high level noise when excavating.
- Traffic management will be in place as required.
- Construction vehicles will access the site via Colebrook Street.
- Upfield Shared Path will remain open with traffic management at some times.
- Access to local properties will be maintained.
- Tram services will not be affected.

When?

Night works ongoing, from 9pm to 5am, to the end of August 2024 (Sunday to Thursday nights only).

Where possible at particular locations we will undertake service proving during the day, 8am to 4pm, to minimise some disruption to the community.



Cont'd. Service proving investigations

What to expect?

- Vehicles, machinery and contractors on site.
- Mostly low to medium level noise, with some high-level noise if excavation is required.
- Activity will only be in one locality at a time.
- Further notification will be provided for specific dates when locations are closer to residential properties.
- Access to local properties will be maintained.
- Traffic management will be in place.
- Tram services will not be affected.
